Case Study

The Corsham School

The Corsham School is an 11-18 mixed comprehensive in Wiltshire, educating children of all abilities and received an Outstanding Ofsted report in 2009. The school gained specialist status in the visual arts in September 2003 and met the criteria for High Performing Status in 2006. The second specialism in Maths and ICT provides a dynamic complement to the school's creative learning ethos. The number on roll is currently 1400 with 270 in the sixth form.

I became the Electronic Learning Environment (ELE) Manager in September 2007 and introduced the Frog Learning Platform to the school over a period of 12 months. It has been a massive success improving communication across the school, engaging students in new technology and enabling us to achieve a 24/7 learning reality. Once ELE was up and running I decided to investigate what other opportunities there were for integrating services within the learning platform. Frog is a very flexible learning platform that can be used to host other companies' applications and all SCORM compliant software. Our existing library software was out of date and uninspiring so I always had the plan to upgrade to something more engaging. Our Librarian

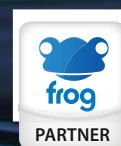
had previously used Eclipse.net, in another school, and was extremely keen to upgrade our existing system.

I visited the MLS stand at BETT in 2009, for the first time, and was impressed by the versatility of the software and the way that it could be incorporated into our Learning Platform. The decision was made to purchase the software in 2010 and it couldn't have come soon enough! MLS allowed us to spread the cost of the new software over three years which also helped our budget.

Integrating the software into Frog was extremely easy, once the software was setup on the server and the address has been published. You add a Frog 'scroll frame brick' to the page and simply type in the address.

Originally we installed the non-Silverlight version which worked well but didn't have the modern look that I was after. After contacting the MLS helpdesk we upgraded to the latest version and I was extremely happy with the results. The student page has a much more modern, widget driven feel on a super glossy black background. There are all sorts of additional features with the top ten resources and new arrivals all displayed using Silverlight animation. There is even a Sliding Puzzle game that the students can interact with the cover of the Book of the Week! It makes using the library so much more fun and engaging inside the school and at home. For the first time students are able to manage their books online, write reviews, watch authors talking about their books with 'Meet the Author' and Teachers can set homework using the library software.
